

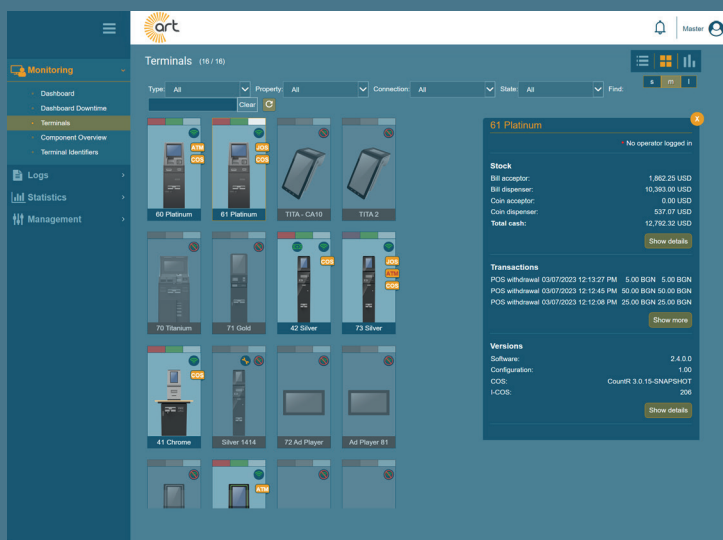
The ART Web Client provides an overview over your CountR terminals. It runs in any modern browser. It provides an insight into the terminal processes by:

- providing Monitoring of the connected terminals, their states, transactions and utilization at a glance in the ART Dashboard
- providing Statistics of the data collected by ART Server to help you make informed decisions
- providing Logs of activities on the terminals and ART Server itself, be them transactions, events, configurations changes, or operator access audits
- providing Management of day-to-day data including operator accounts

Monitoring ART Web Client

The Monitoring section of ART Web Client consists mainly of two parts:

- the Dashboard which provides a bird's eye view of keypoints of interest (KPIs) of how your casino and terminals are doing and what trends are emerging
- the Terminal Views provide detailed information for every aspect of the terminal operation you can inspect terminals in the section – check their state, check their fill levels, get recent transaction information and control their operation.



Logs

The log views provide access to log entries generated for various logs.

The Transaction Log contains all the transaction reported by terminals connected to ART Server. They are sorted chronologically descending per default and can be filtered in many ways. The number of transactions displayed depends on the selections for transaction types, terminals, the operator (or player) that initiated the transaction, the selected time period. Based on the chosen 'Items per Page' size you'll get more or less pages to page through. The Flags column can show multiple flags for any given transaction.

By selecting a single terminal you can see all logs from these, sorted with tabs.

Statistics

At the ART Web Client you can find all statistics for your terminals. These includes:

- Transaction Statistics
- Cash Statistics
- Card Statistics
- Online System Statistics
- Payment Reports
- Balancing Reports
